- Monthly virtual country leaders' meeting ongoing; 4 done






#### **Growing Membership**

- Just under 70% of members based in Africa




## IAPHL members by continent



■ Africa Asia North America South America Europe Central America Australia




## Monthly Membership Growth






#### **Membership Growth**






#### Gender




#### **Supply Chain Sector**






#### **Monthly contributions**





#### **Cumulative contributions**






### Website performance




#### **New IAPHL website users**




## Average session duration on the IAPHL website






## Page views on the website
