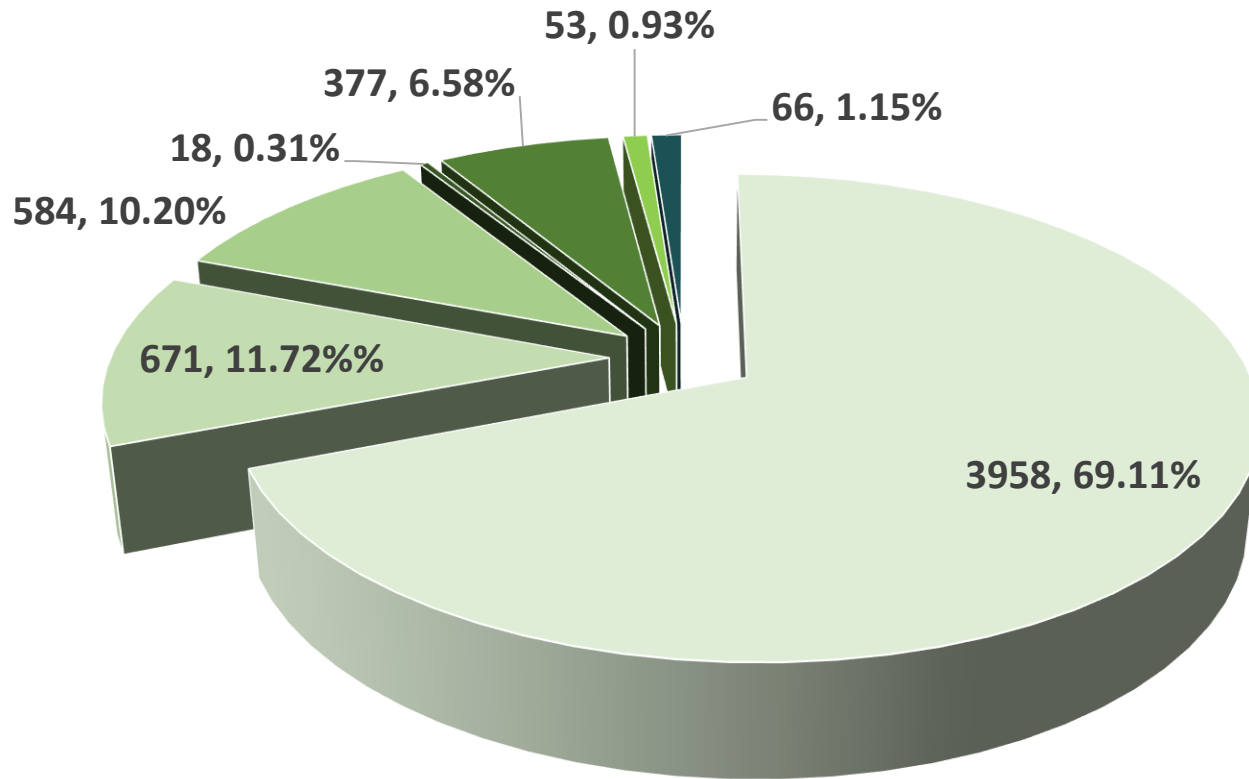
Membership

Membership Growth



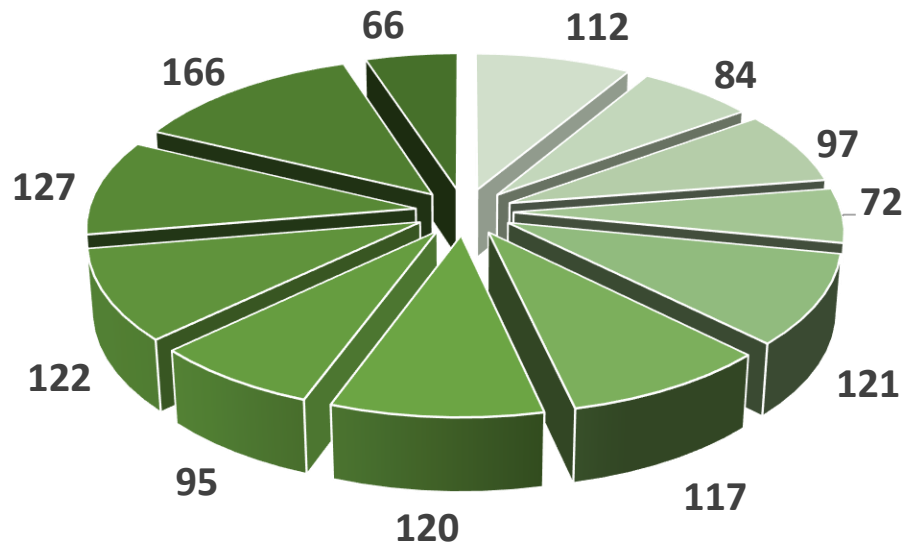
Members by Continent

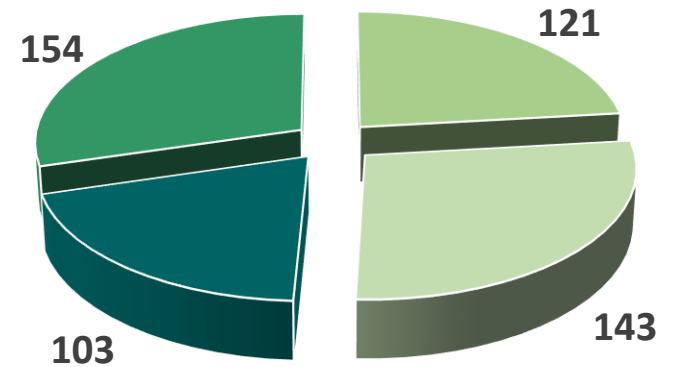

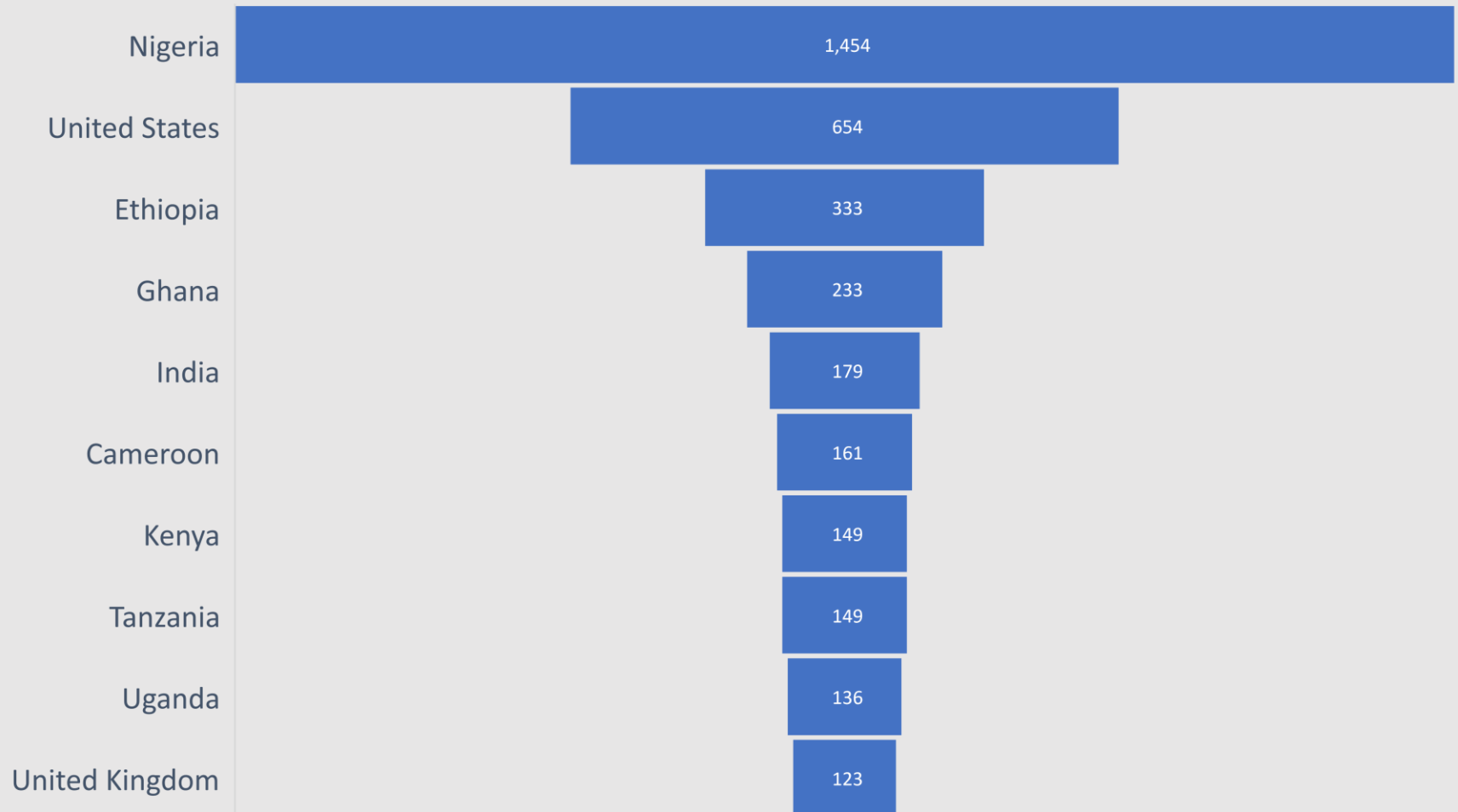

Top 10 Countries



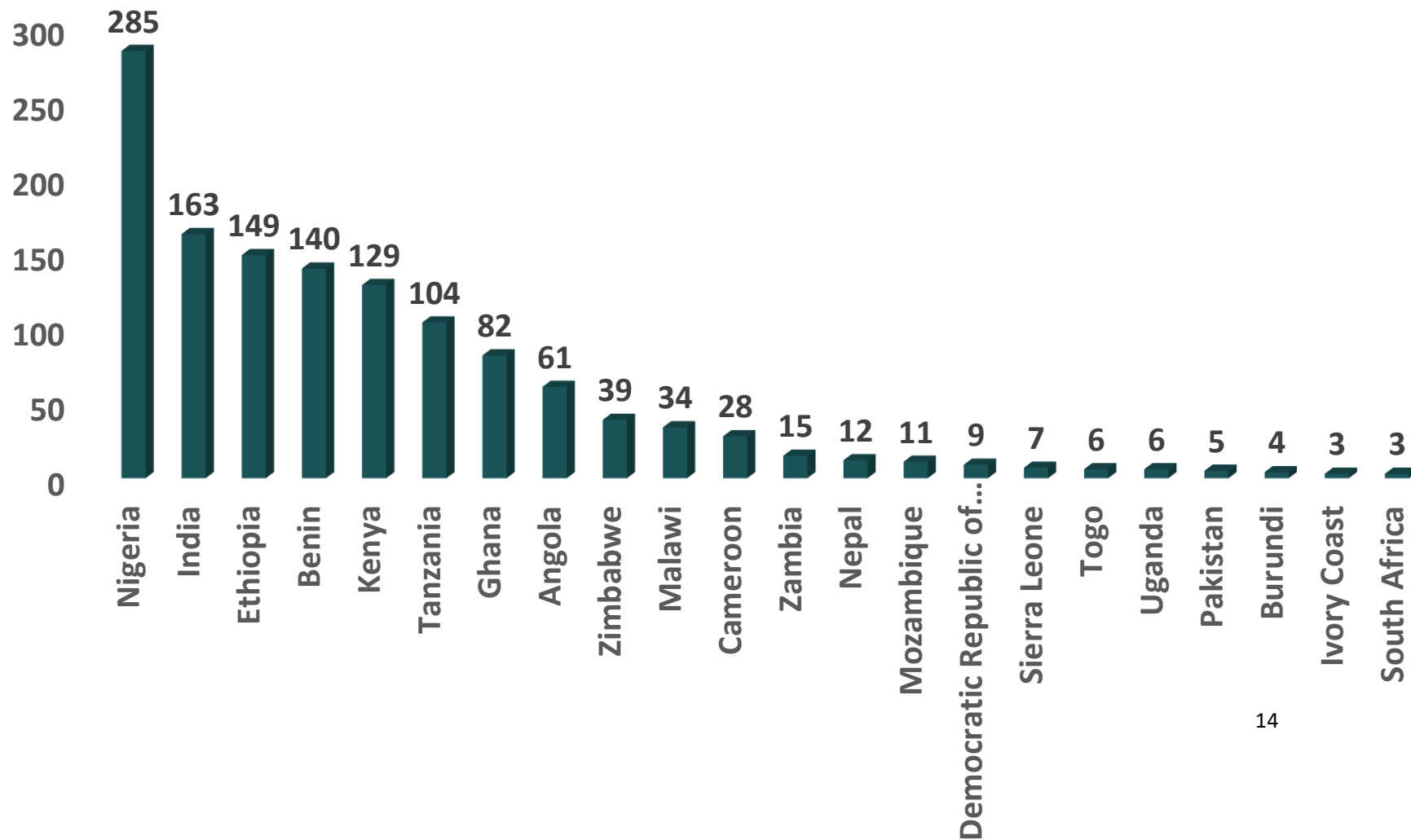

- Humanitarian Logistics Portal created Nov 2018 and currently has 191 members.

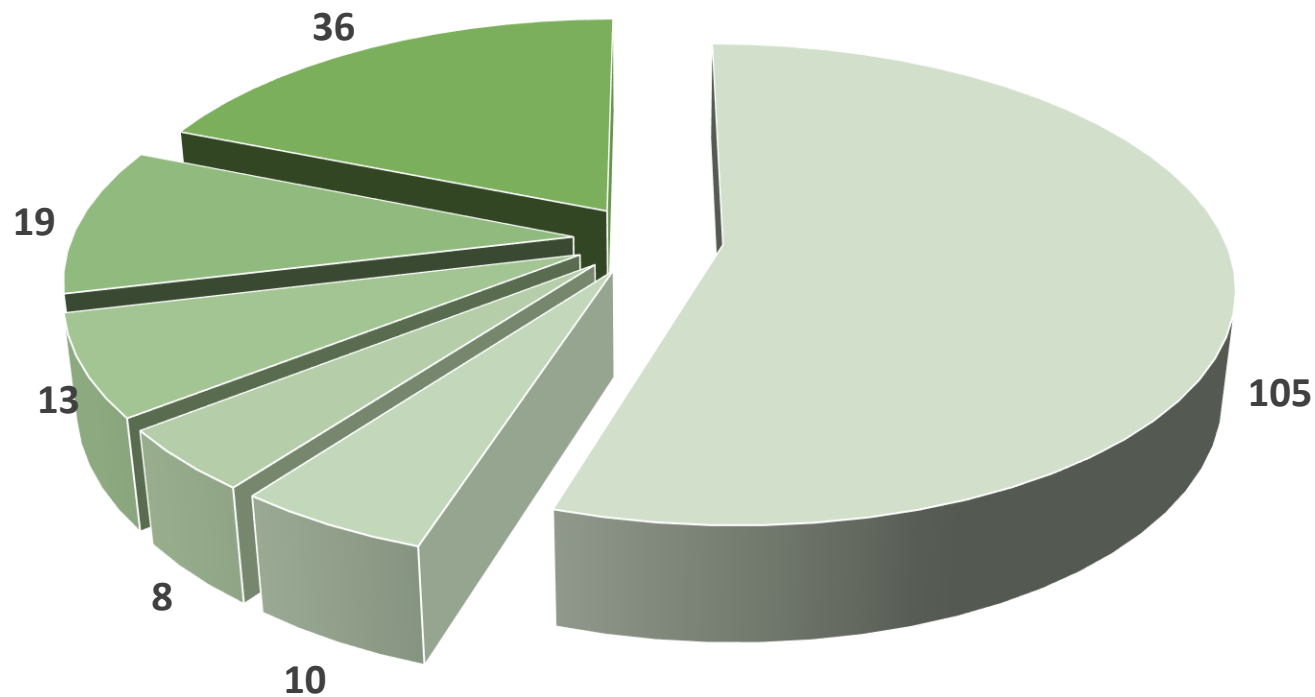

Humanitarian Logistics Join Rate



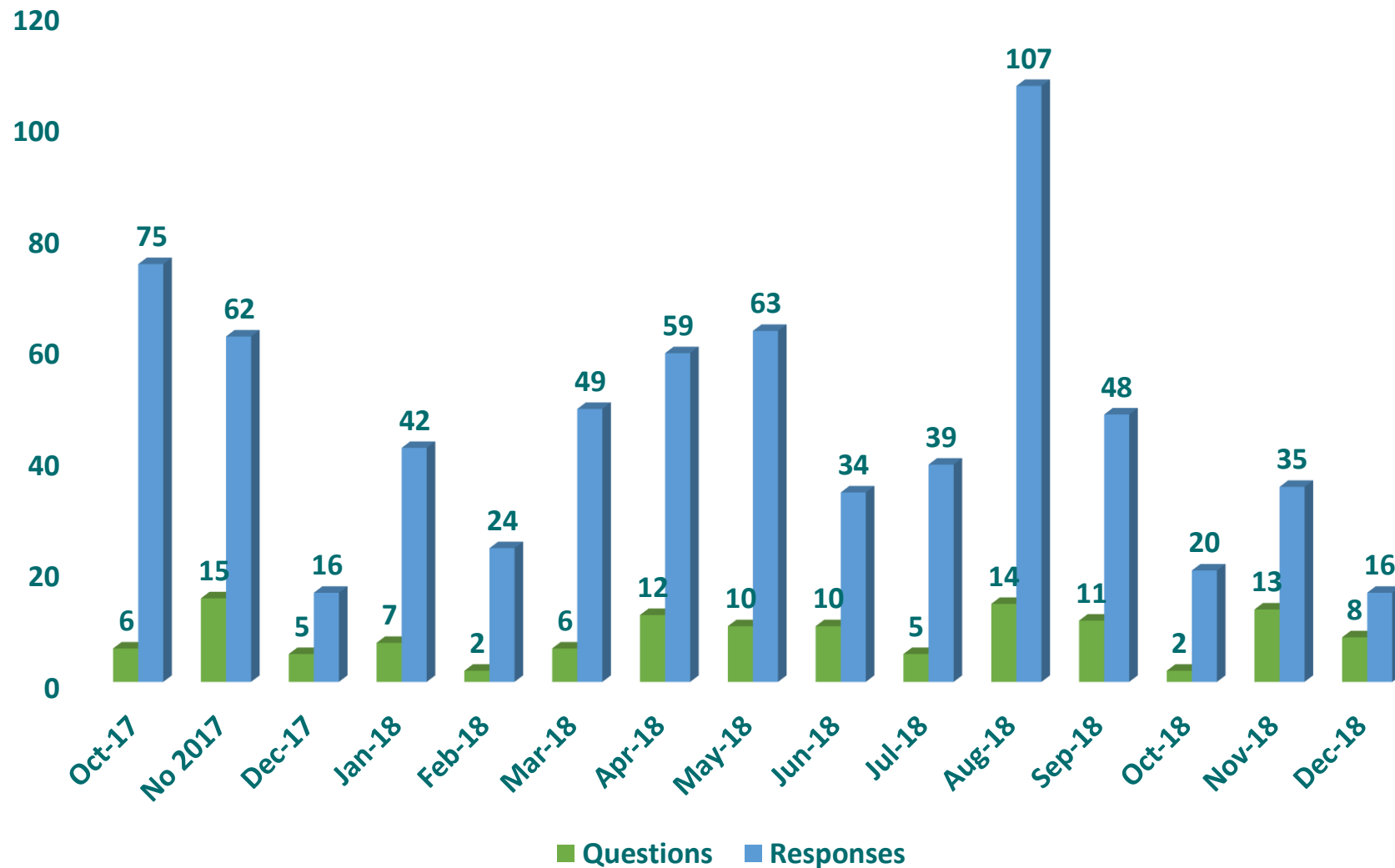

Listserv Operations

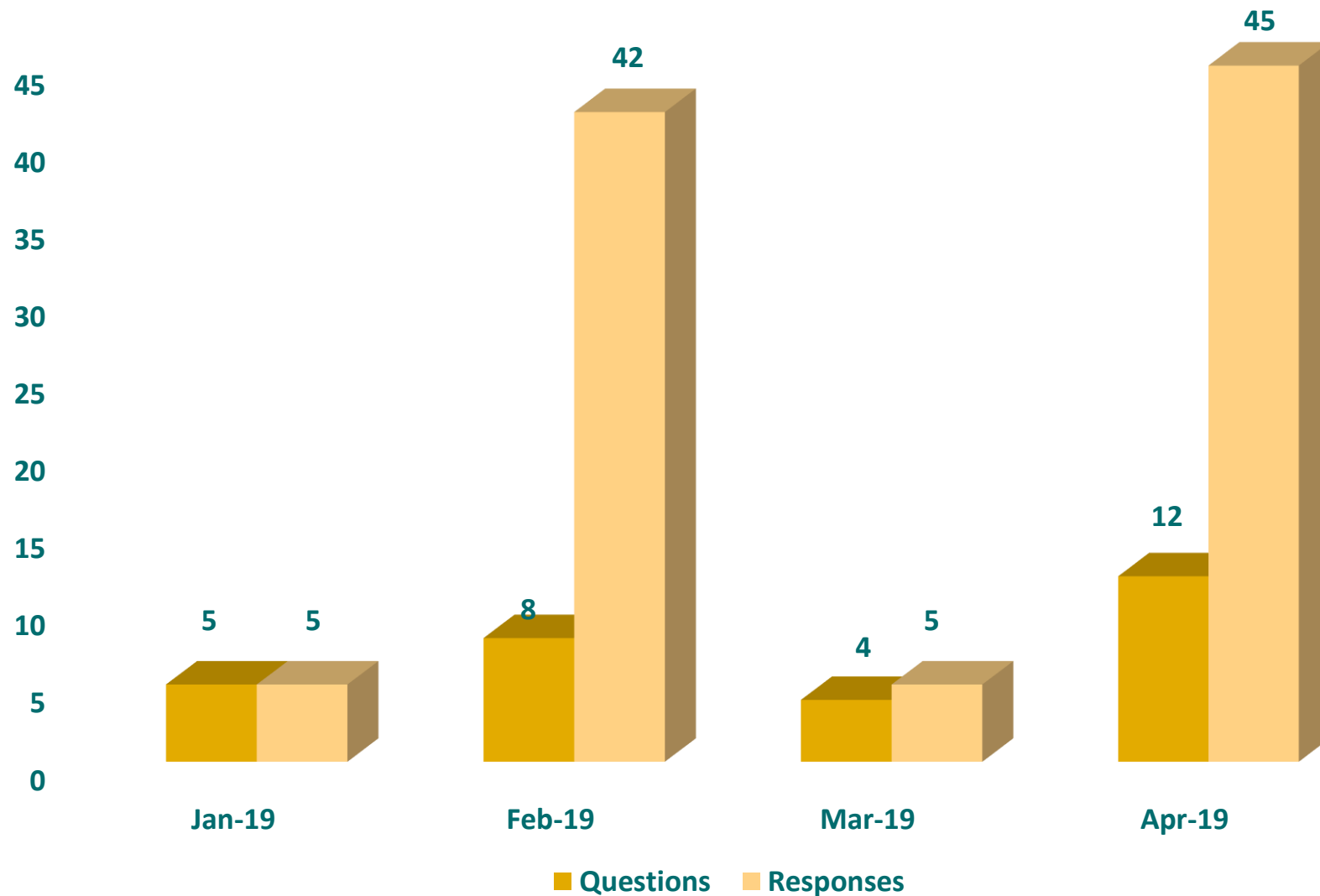
Operations- opportunity to embed real-time exchanges of current SC knowledge & expertise in members' day-to-day work

Questions and Responses 2017 - 2018



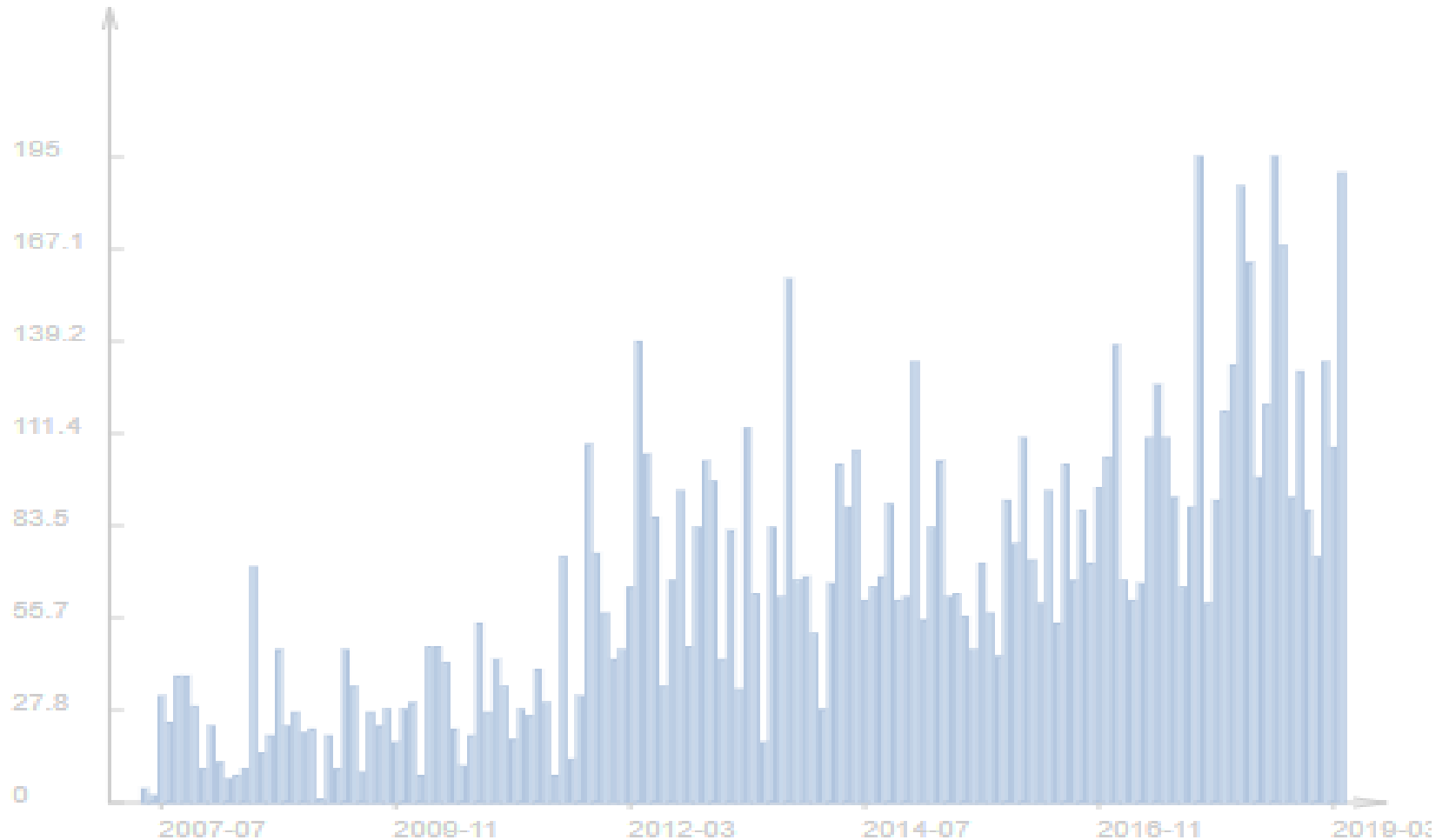

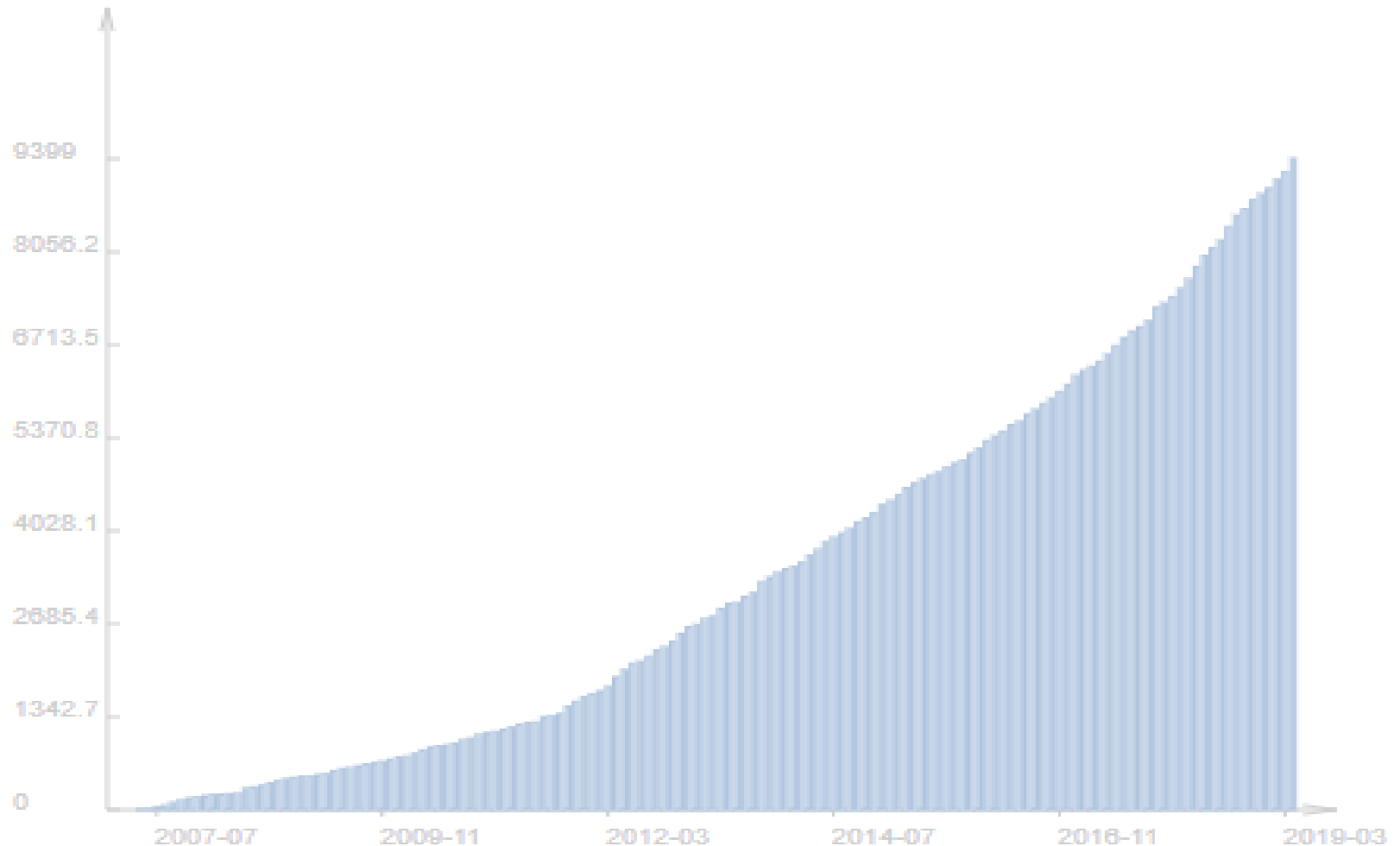
Questions and Responses 2018 - 2019

- IAPHL has received a total of 160 requests from members from October 11, 2017 – April 29, 2019.
- 111 requests received 786 responses from IAPHL members.
- 49 requests didn't receive any response.
- 64 requests received same day responses.
- 31 requests received next day responses.
- 16 requests responses a few days later

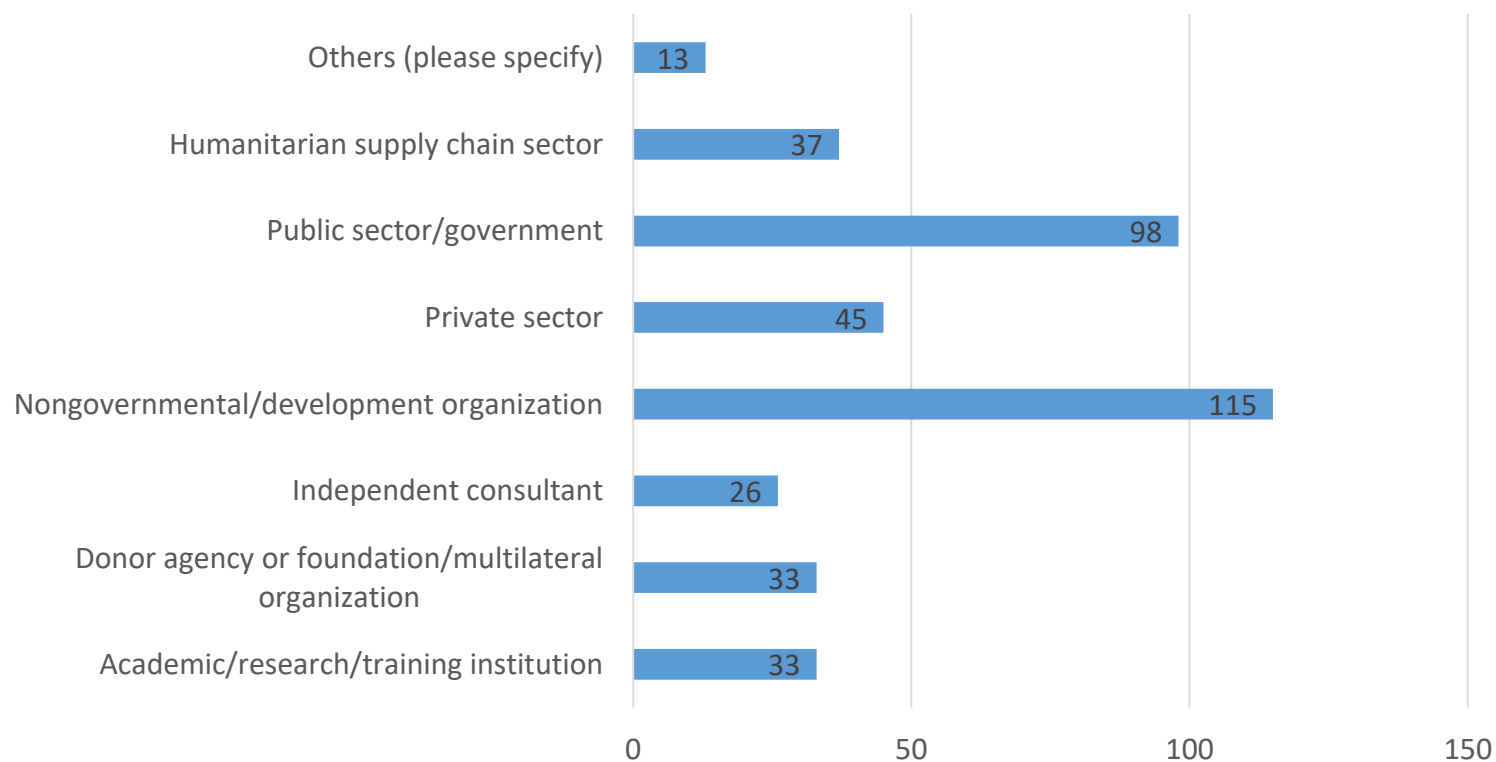

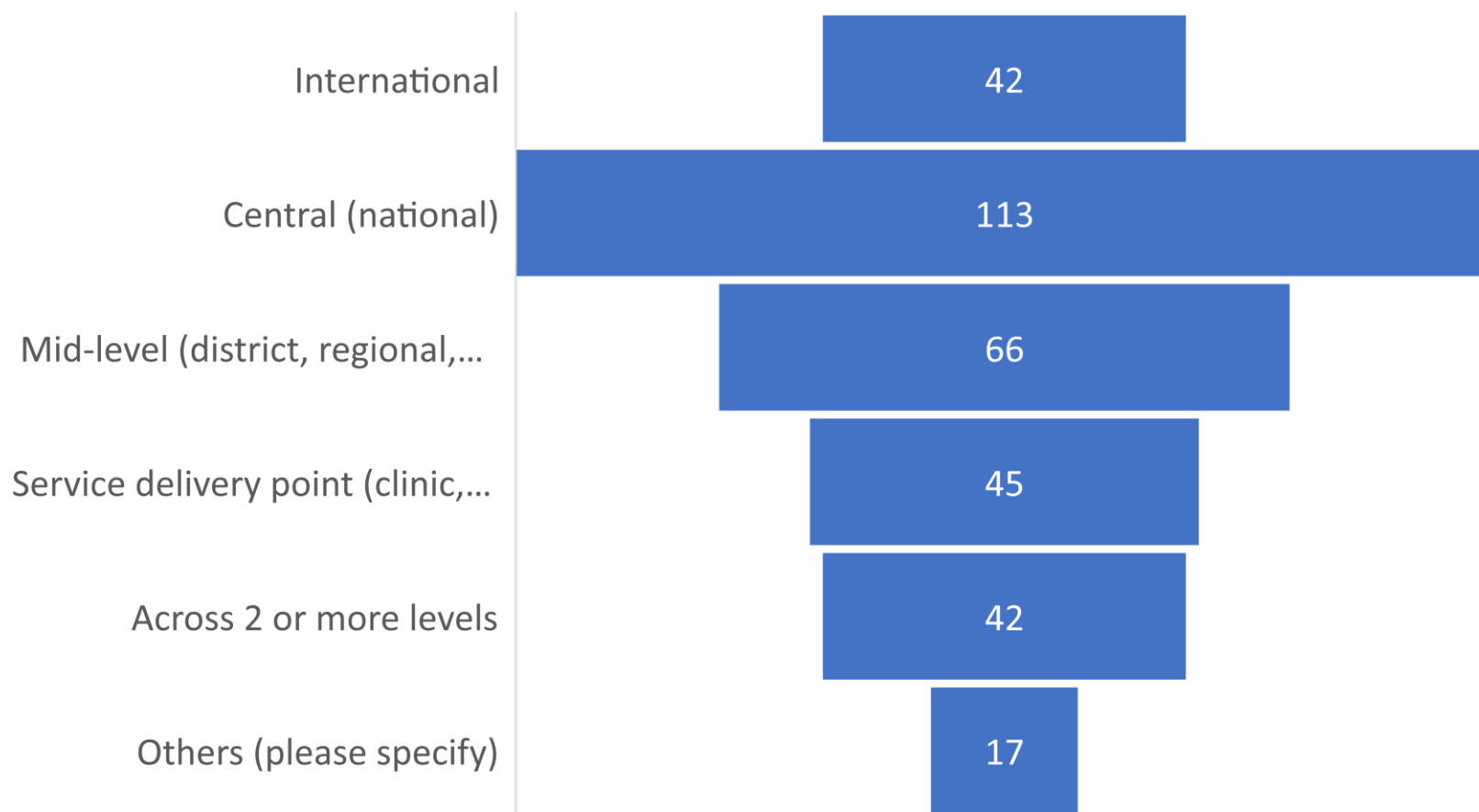

- 325 vs 520 in 2018

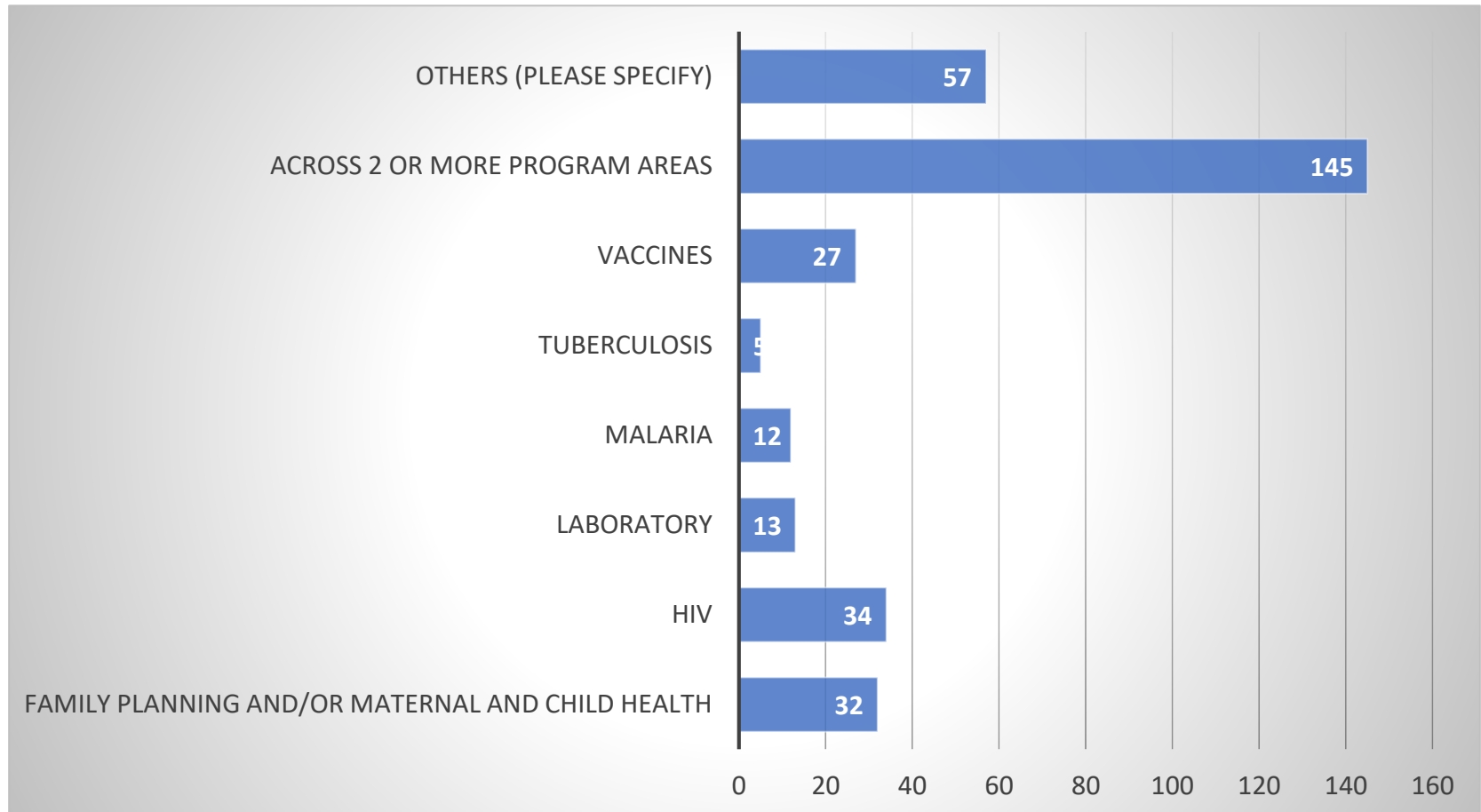
2019 Survey: Supply Chain Sector



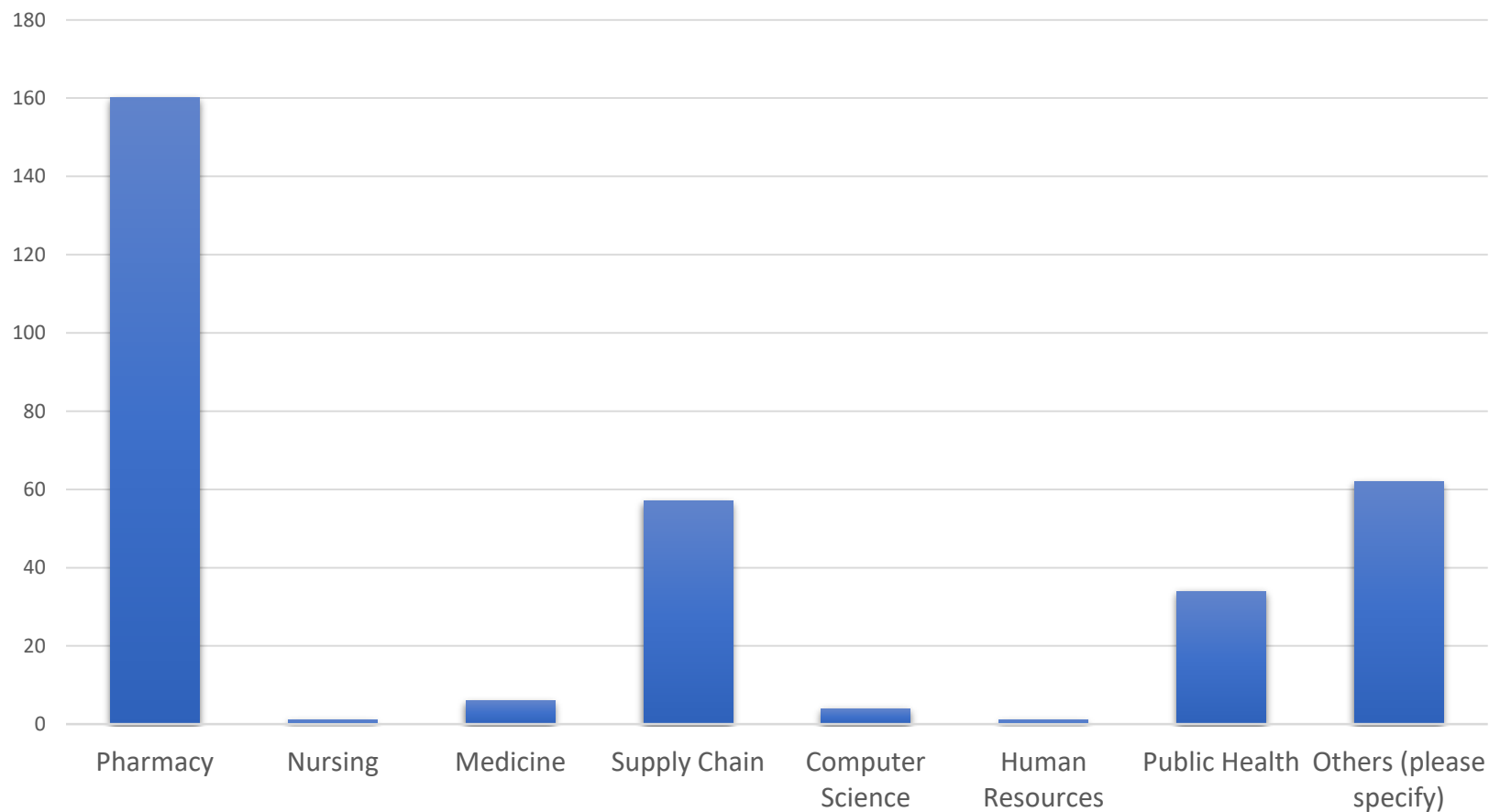
2019 Survey: Supply Chain Level



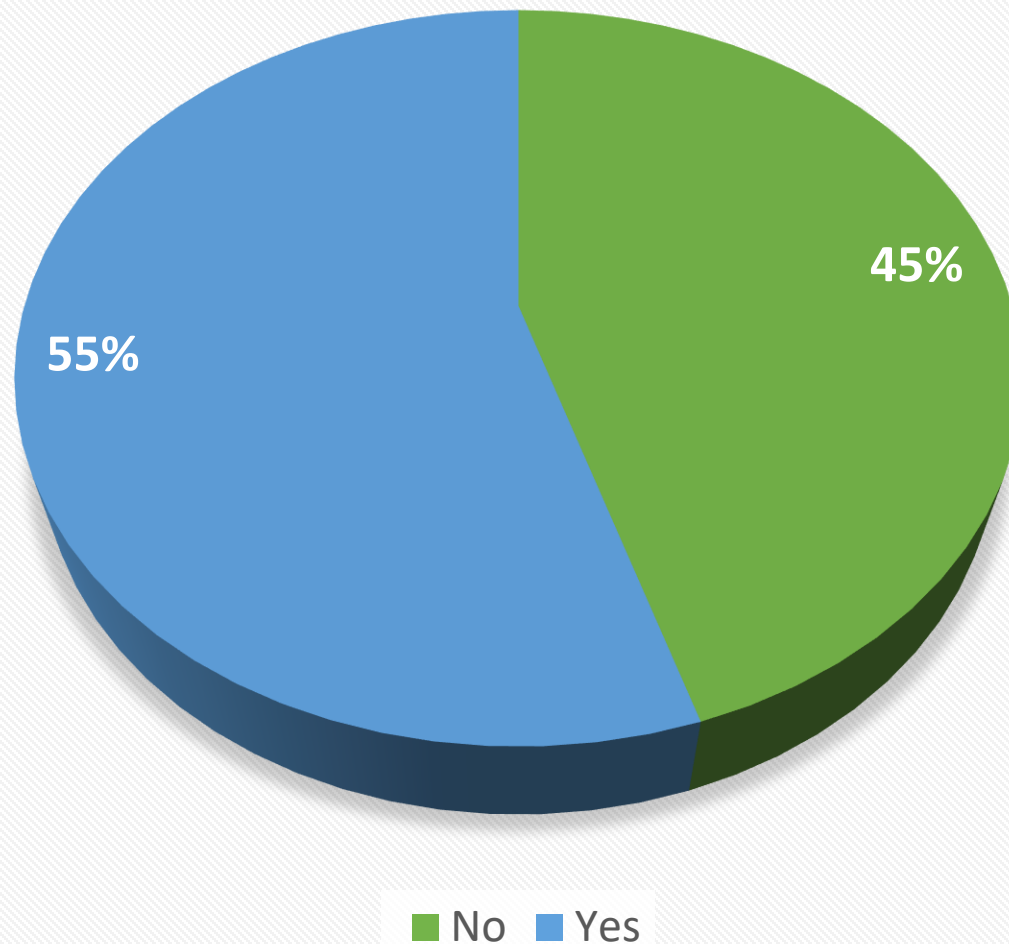
2019 Survey: Commodity Program Area



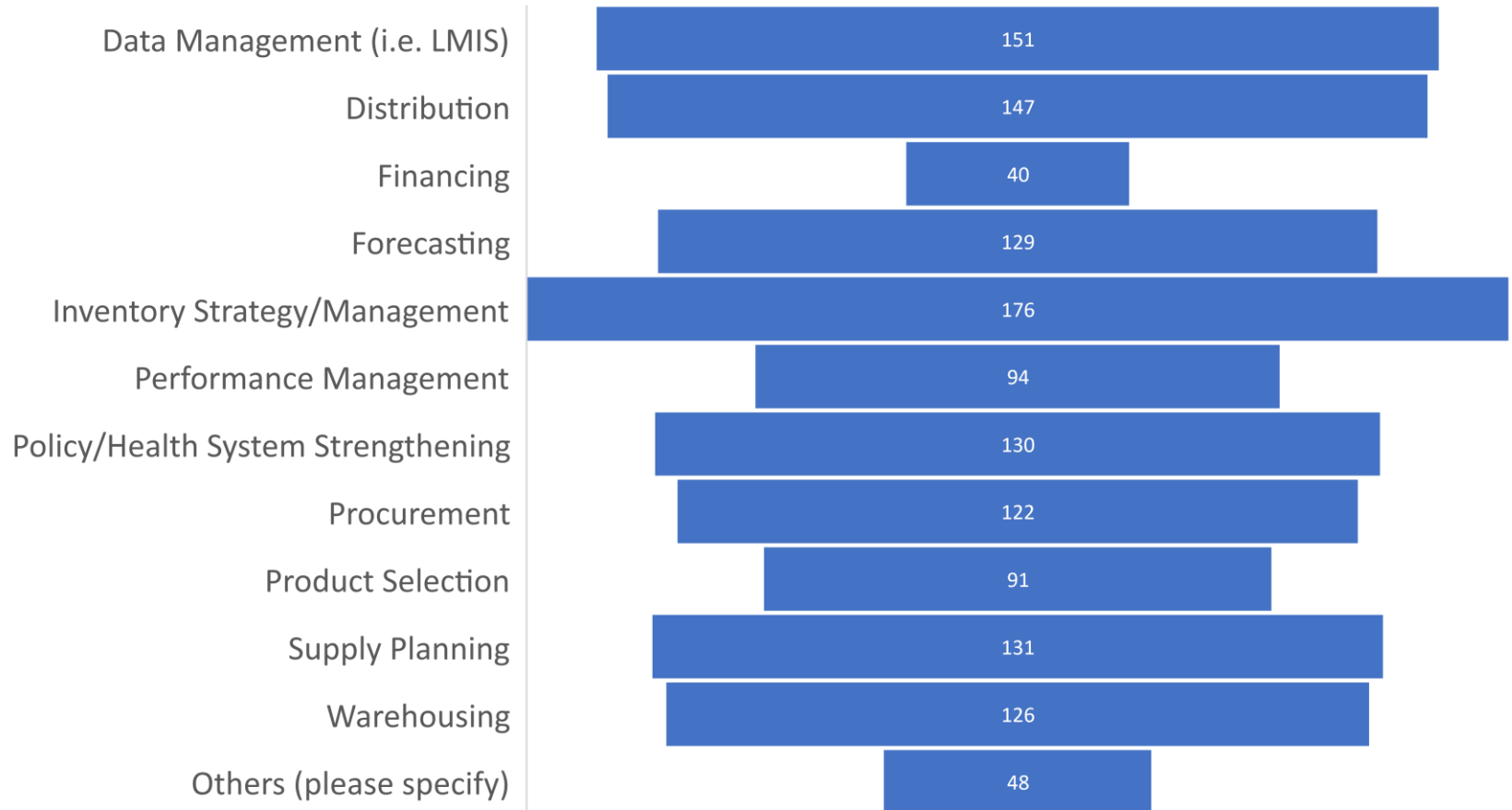
Survey: Educational Background



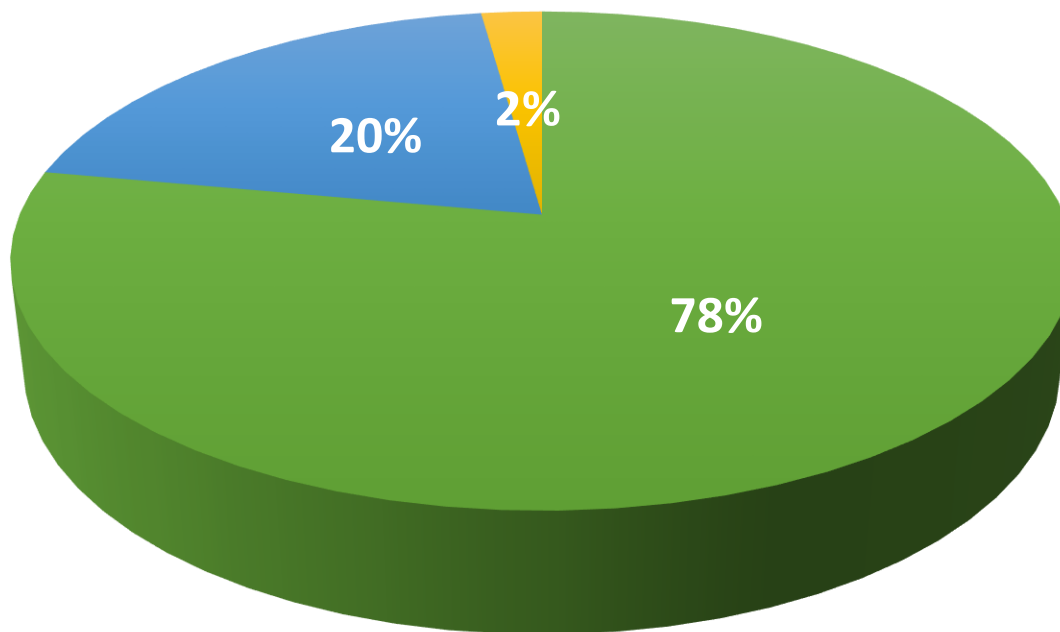
Survey: Supply Chain Certifications



IAPHL Survey: Supply Chain Functions

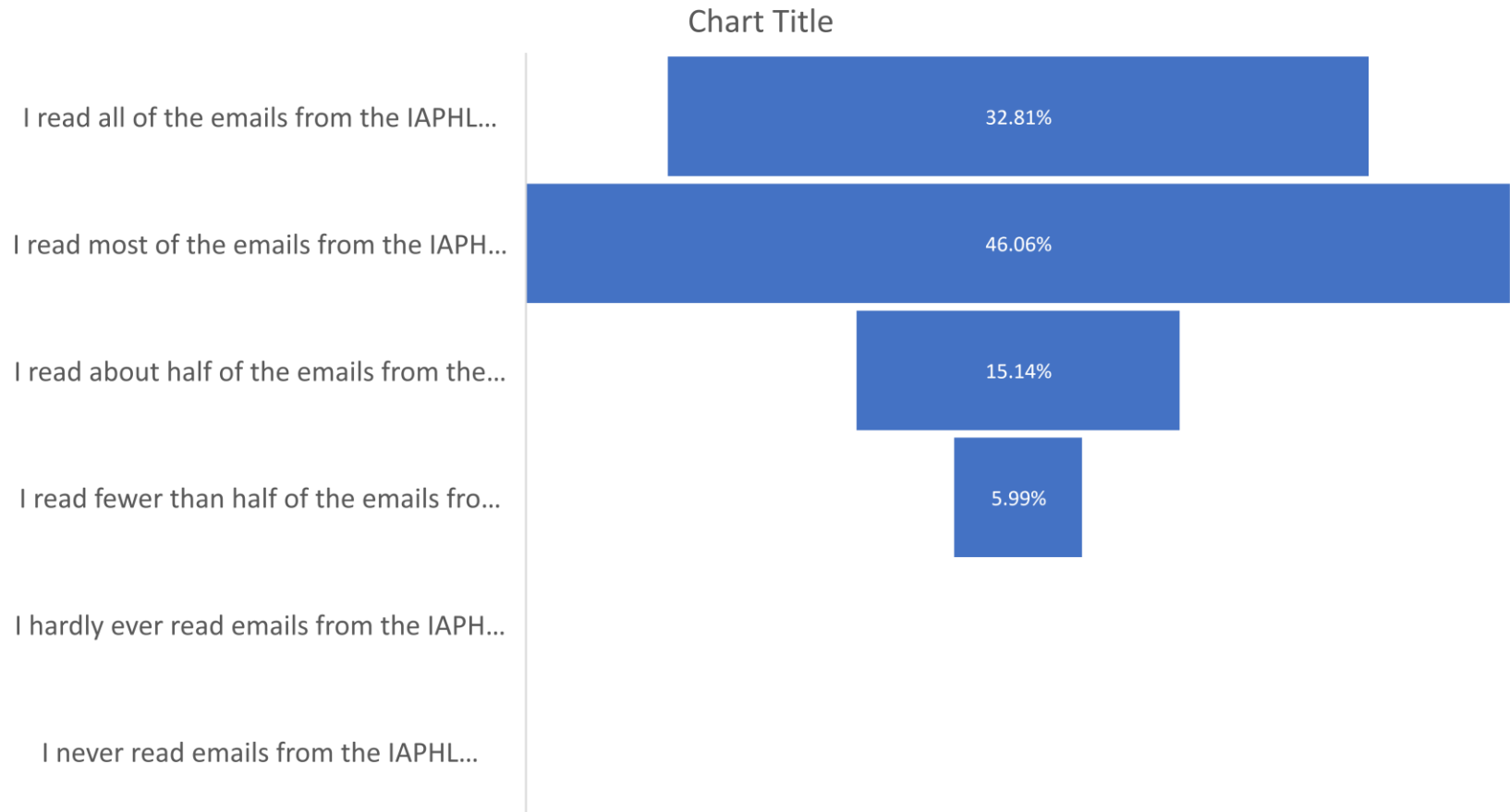

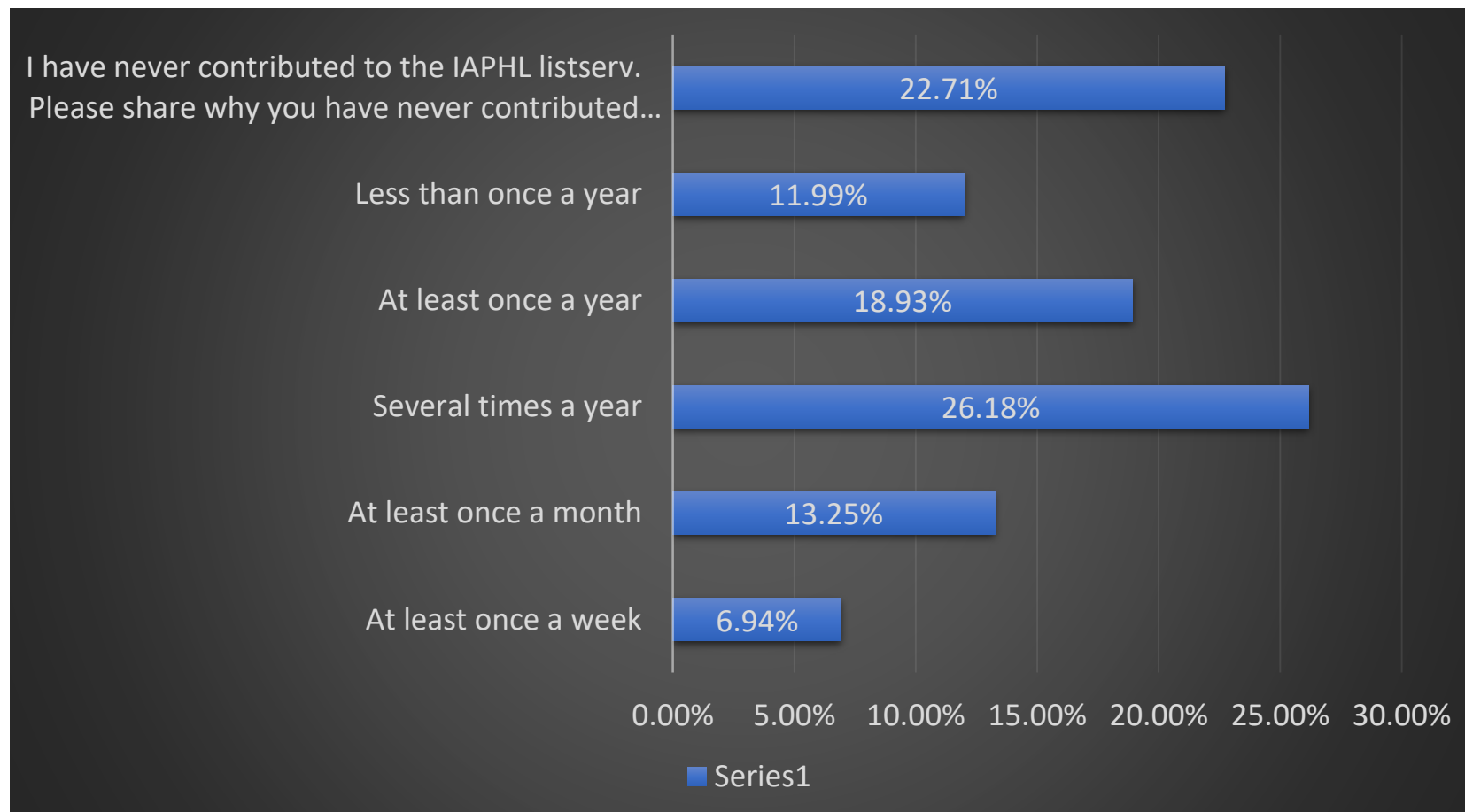

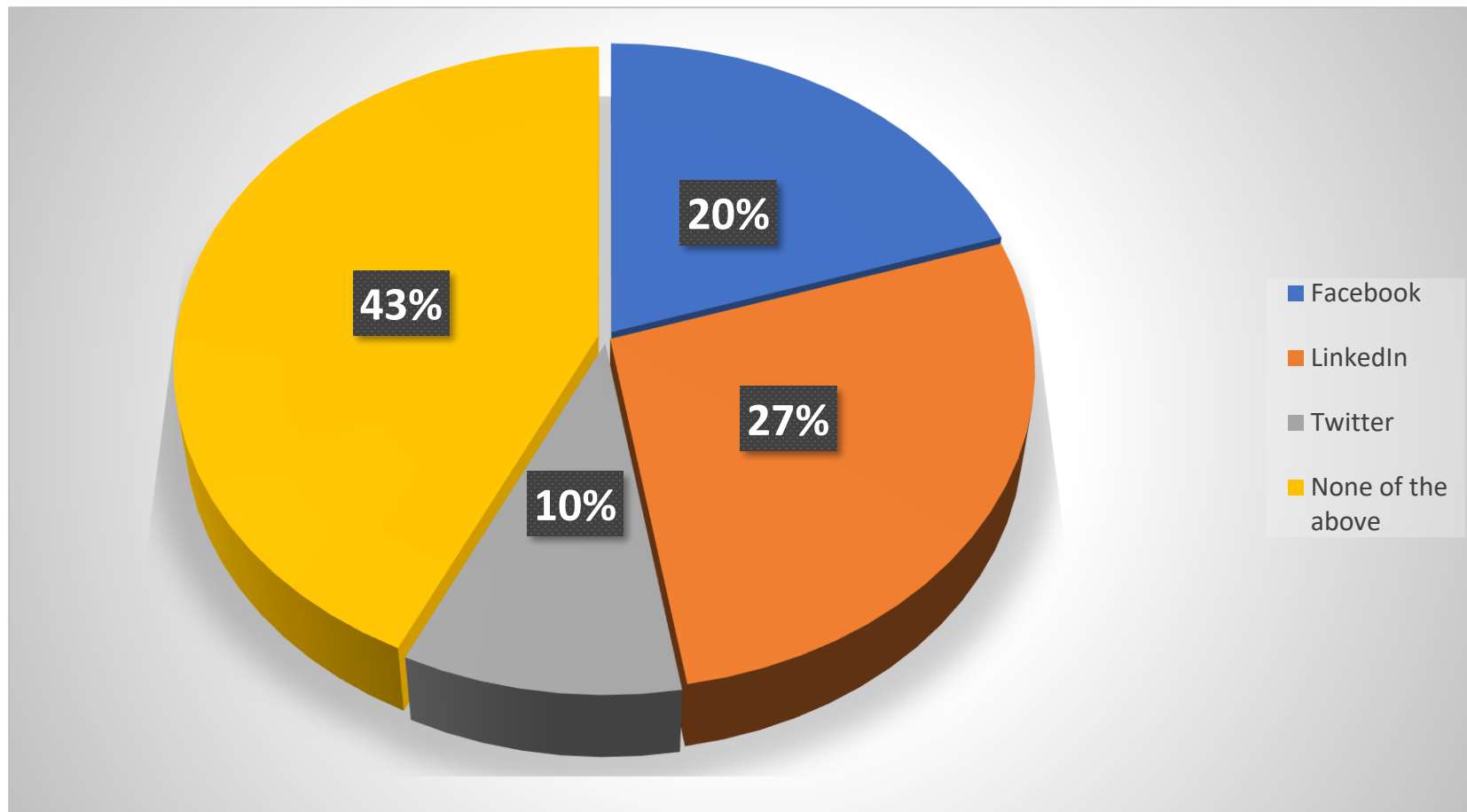
Survey: How frequently do you read emails from the listserv?



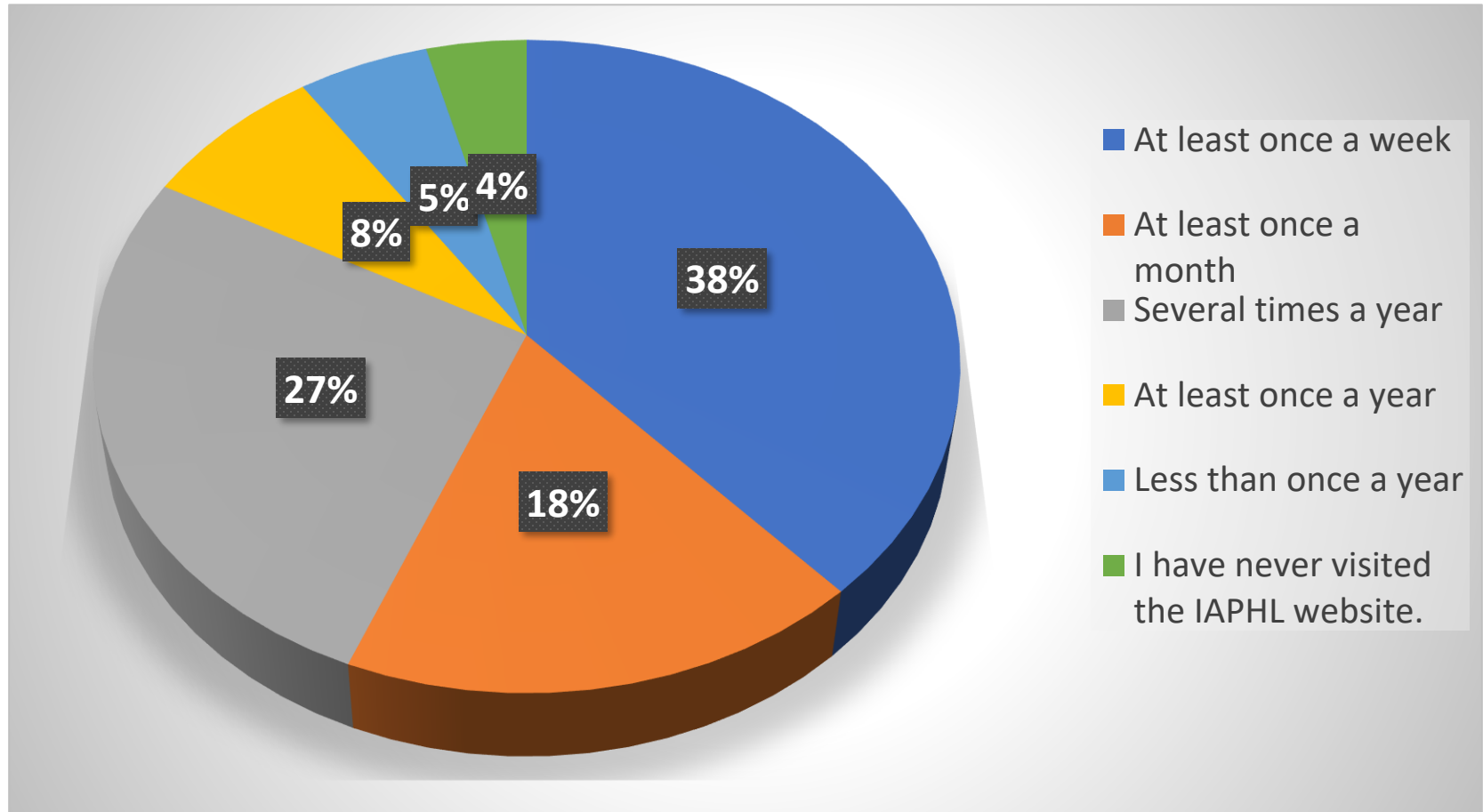
Survey: How frequently do you contribute to the listserv?



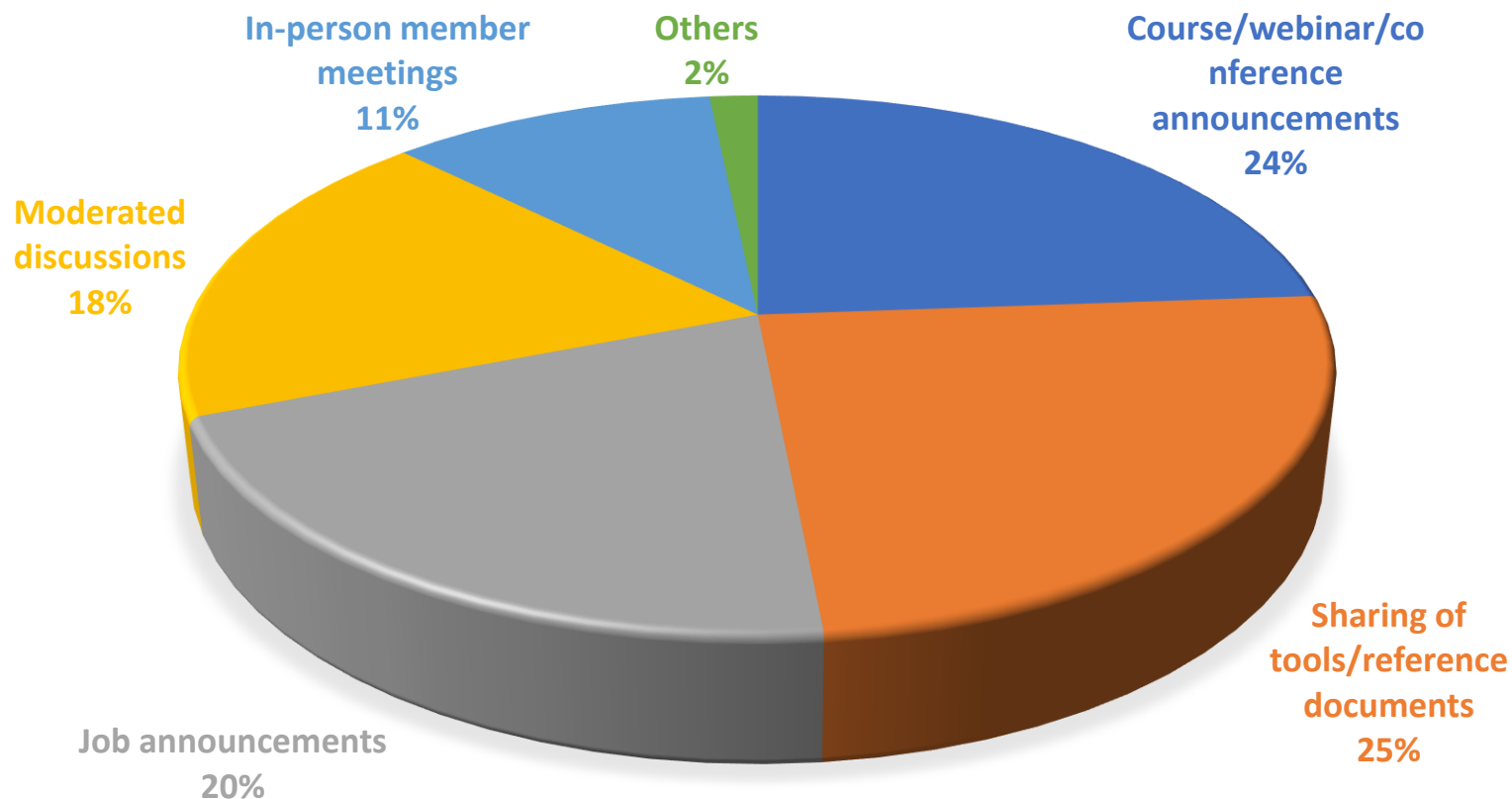
Survey: On which social media outlets do you follow IAPHL?



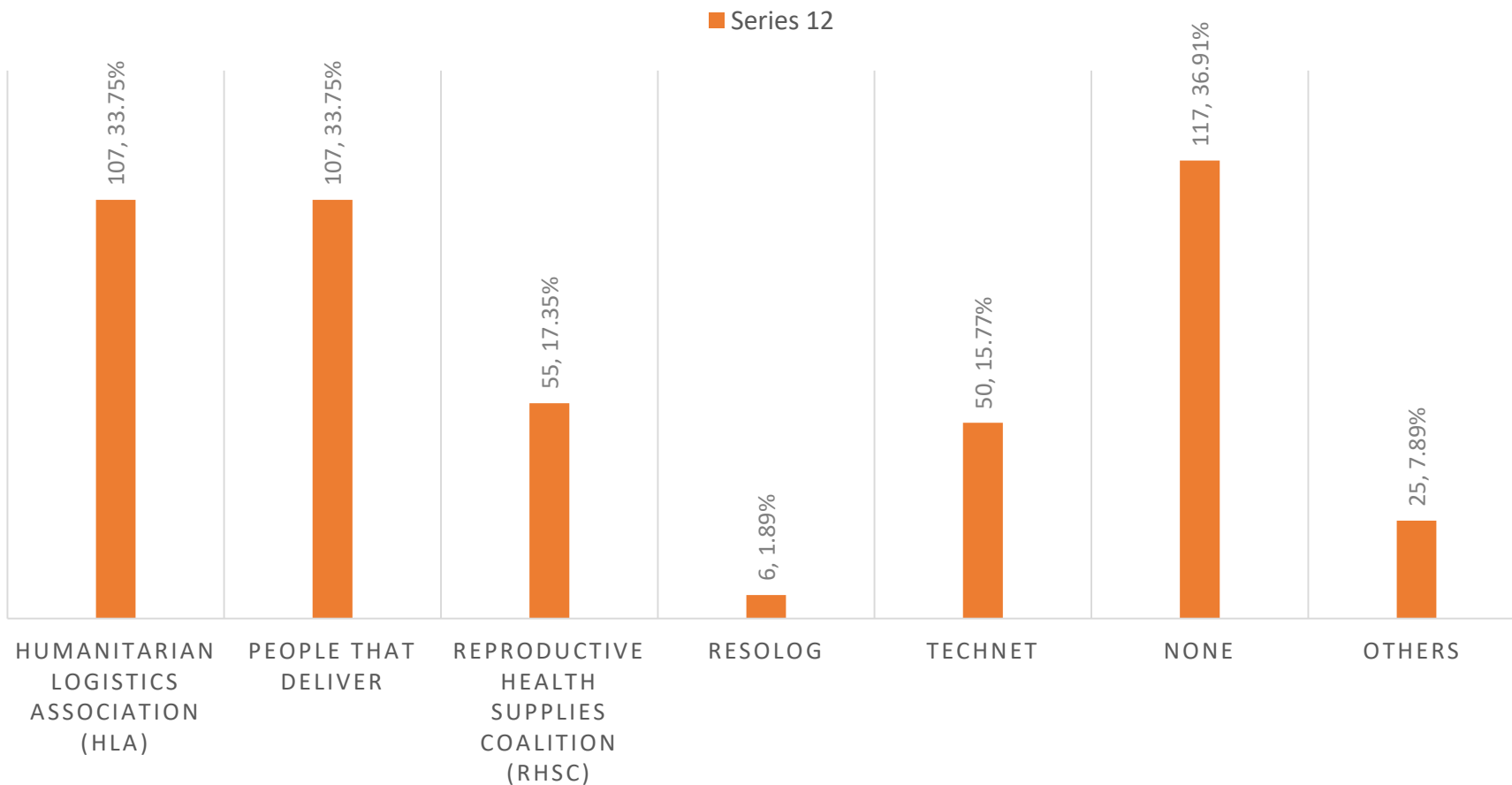
Survey: How frequently do you visit the IAPHL website?



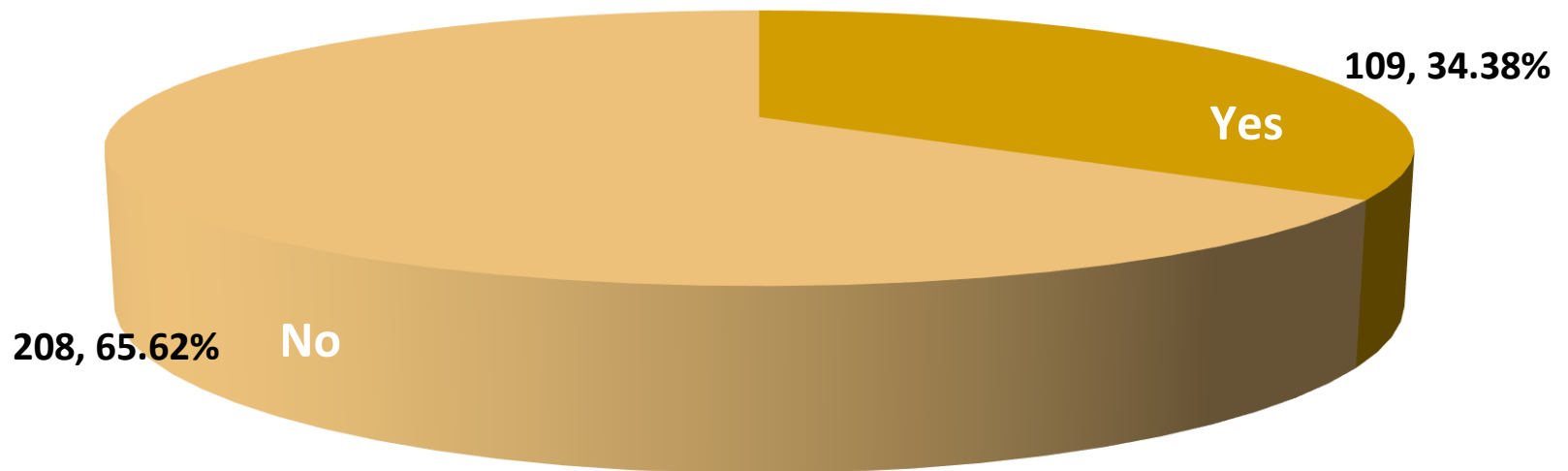
Survey: Which of the following IAPHL services would you like to see more of?



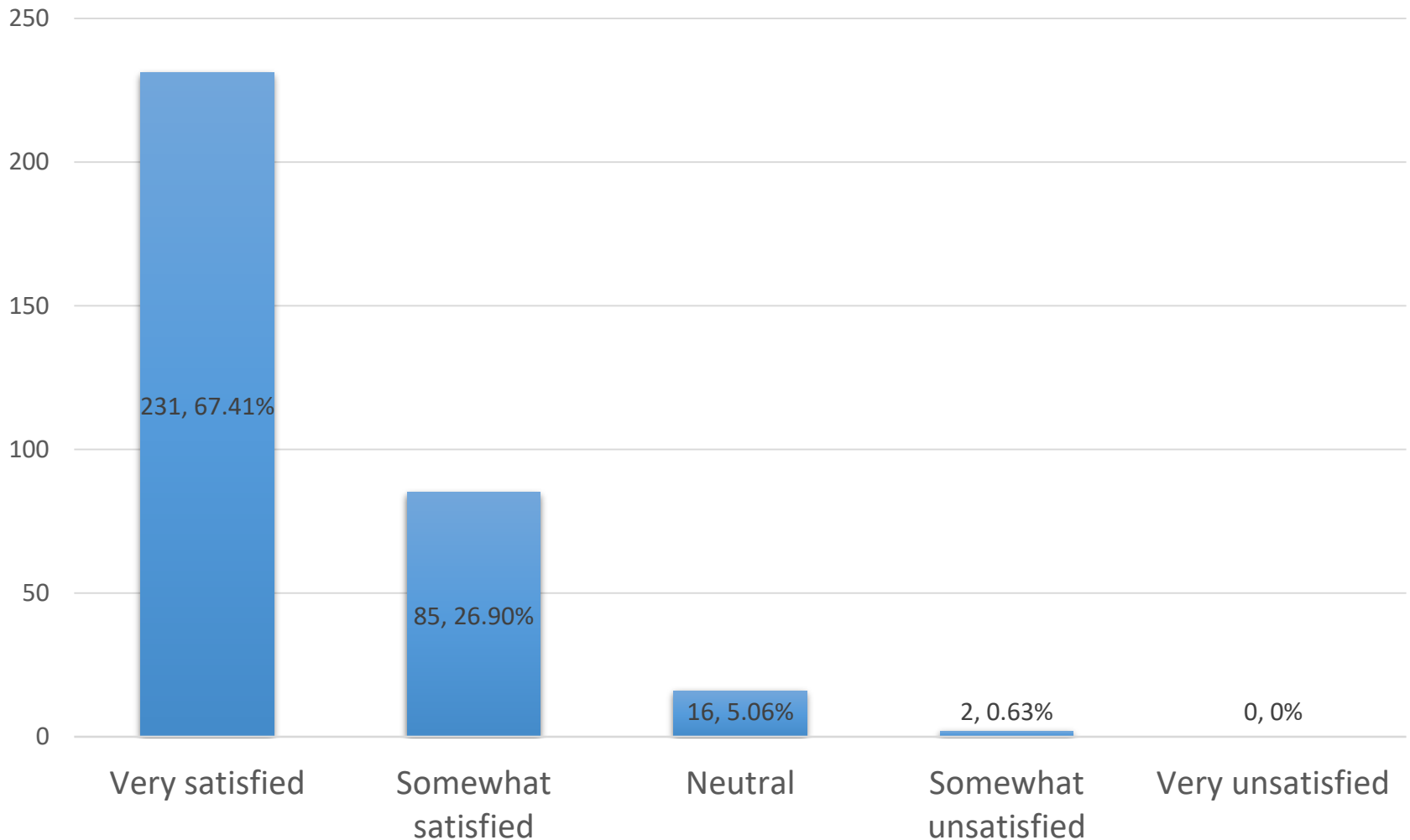
Survey: In addition to IAPHL, which of the following related organizations do you engage with (this includes online engagement and/or membership)?



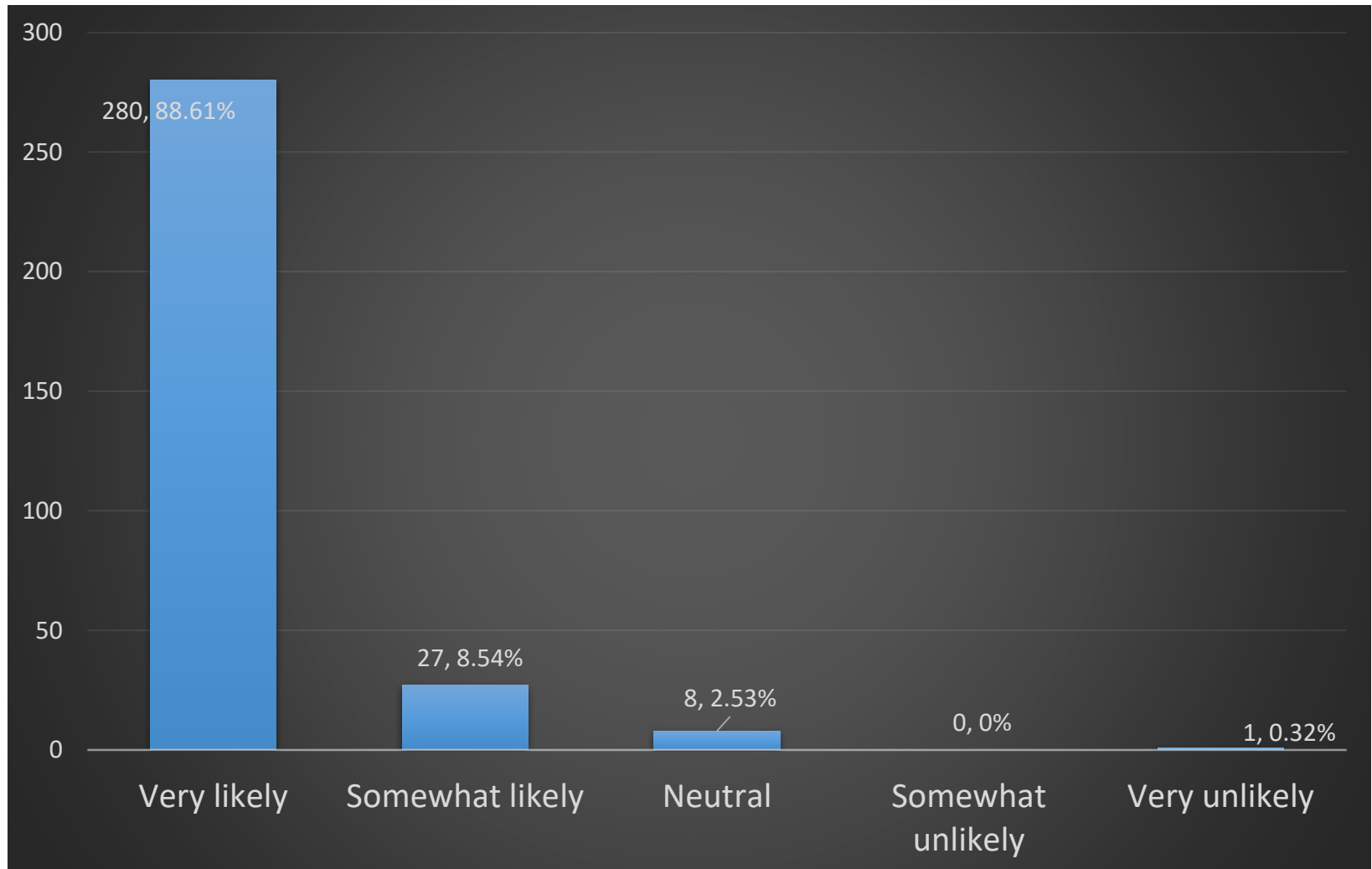
Survey: Have you applied for any of the jobs posted on the IAPHL portal?
